God is with us... and in this fact, we rest and continue to serve.

This Christmas, accept Jesus Christ as your Savior and Lord. Give Him the gift that He wants—your heart, your soul, your life.

GUAM/PHILIPPINES. We thank God that He spared Guam from Tropical Storm Man-Yi. We had strong winds and rain, but not enough to cause damage. The Philippines, however, was greatly affected by Super Typhoon Pepito. This is after experiencing 5 typhoons in 23 days! Our mission stations scattered in the Polillo islands experienced its strong winds and heavy rains. Roofs, ceilings were damaged, a tree fell unto one of our church buildings. Our PMF Church buildings became emergency shelters for the village communities: PMF Apad housed 40 families; PMF Guinaygayan – 28 families; PMF Busdak – 6 families; and our PMF Patnanungan Academy, 4 families. We are so thankful we can be of help to the community we serve and show the love of Jesus to them. Please pray for the clean-up and restoration/rebuilding.

PMA BAHAY KALINGA, NAUJAN, OR. MINDORO, PHILIPPINES. Our Center Head, Micah Oda, reported recently: "Our PMA Social Worker, Ann Caspe, has successfully presented the case of one of our children for matching. Thanks be to God, the child has been matched with the adoptive parents. Please pray for the child and would-be parents, for smooth transition and for bonding of child and parents and most especially that they would raise up this child in the wisdom, knowledge and grace of our Lord Jesus Christ.

**REPUBLIC OF PALAU.** We started this month by celebrating **Brock Welge**'s Birthday. We praise God for His faithfulness to Brock and his family. Brock went to the U.S. for his Fly Right training to fly the King Air. We thank God that he successfully passed this. We did a MEDEVAC for one of our regular passengers who had a broken hip in Angaur. She arrived at the airport safely, transferred her to an ambulance and was driven straight to the hospital. The men of the PMF church conducted a retreat, and they started to rebuild the summer house in Angaur where the Saturday Bible study is held. We also did a sea search with the Marine Law enforcement, 170 miles northwest of Palau for a Chinese fishing vessel who was illegally in Palau waters. They said that they went there to avoid the strong typhoon.
