YAP, MICRONESIA. Our friends Pastor Erik Spohr and David Knoll from Centerville Christian Fellowship in Ohio, came to Yap for their 4th visit in the last 7 years. We ended the visit with a flight out to the Island of Fais, where we did an outreach to the small PMF Church group out there.
