Dear Praying Friends and Faithful Partners,

“Teach us to make the most of our time, so that we may grow in wisdom.”

I thank God for them! When I returned the only damage were to trees and flowering shrubs which our young people helped me to clean up and dispose of the debris. Team Yap was also here: **Amos Collins, Mark Abbot** and **Jonas Schuh** as they assisted in the Saipan Relief and recovery mission transporting teams from Samaritan’s Purse. May God be glorified in all our efforts.

**PHILIPPINES.** The Lord allowed me to attend with all eleven of our PMF churches in the Philippines the annual Family Camp—a beautiful time of fellowship, worship, prayer, games, and shared meals as more than 300 adults, youth, and children came together. We ended with a Sunrise and Communion Service and rejoiced as 18 believers followed Christ in water baptism. A glorious day! A few days later, our Manila HQ Team and I traveled to Naujan, Oriental Mindoro to visit our Bahay Kalinga Orphanage. Being with the children and our faithful staff filled my heart, and we were humbled to receive Certificates of Appreciation and to top it off, a warm birthday celebration for me.
