Dear Praying Friends and Faithful Partners,

I remember times in the past practicing action songs that the children would present in a Sunday service. After picking them up from the airport, we met the Guam team for dinner at their favorite spot — a sweet time of fellowship before their late-night flight. I was able to take them shopping afterward and then bring them back to the airport to continue their journey home. We were also delighted to see the **Collins** family as they traveled through Guam enroute to the States for their well-deserved furlough. Our time together was brief, but we thank God for every opportunity to reconnect, encourage one another, and send our missionaries onward with love and prayer.

PHILIPPINES. CDC participants, including those from Guinaygayan, were prioritized for medical care and updated dental records. Led by **Dr. Rowena “Weng” Bautista** and her volunteer team, the one-day mission was a success. We are grateful as well to the RHU, under **Dr. Jomari Dioquino**, for sending two BHWs to assist with medical procedures and tooth extractions. We also thank our **municipal mayor and his office** for providing transportation and accompanying the dentists to Guinaygayan to check the teeth of our CDC participants there.
